Royal National Park Tour - \$10

Nestled between Sydney and Wollongong, the heritage-listed park provides endless opportunities to reconnect with nature and admire its beauty. Lunch will be in the quaint town of Bundeena.

Tramway Museum - \$10 + \$15

The Sydney Tramway Museum is Australia’s oldest and largest tramway museum in the Southern Hemisphere. With a fleet of local, national and international tram cars on display and available to ride. Entry is \$15 for senior and concession card holders. We’ll have lunch at Club Engadine.

Bondi Farmers Market - \$20

Just a step away from Bondi Beach, this market offers Sydneysiders seasonal fruits & veggies, organically grown meat & poultry, farmstead cheeses, olive oils, spices, herbs and so much more! Lunch will be at Bondi Bowling Club.

Cambridge Markets EQ - \$20

Seasonal produce, gourmet treats, and just-picked flowers are some of the offerings at one of Sydney’s oldest markets. Feel good in the knowledge that you’re supporting small business and your groceries come direct from farmers. Lunch will be at Sundeck Brasserie at Juniors Kingsford.

Penrith Panthers Leagues Club - \$10

The leagues club sits proudly in the middle of what has become the impressive and expansive Panthers Precinct. Boasting 11 restaurants and 6 bars, this “world of entertainment” needs to be seen to be believed!

Gourmet Shopper - Llandilo - \$10

Llandilo is a semi-rural outcrop between 2 creeks in Sydney’s western suburbs. We’ll take in the crisp winter air and stop to purchase farm fresh eggs and seasonal produce. Lunch will be St Mary’s Leagues Club. Bring your cooler bags!

Cherry Blossom Festival - \$10 + entry fee

Gourmet Shopper – Springtime in Dural - \$10

Experience this semi-rural town in all its Springtime glory. We'll visit a beautiful nursery, the House of Herbs & Spices and the roadside Dural Kiosk. Lunch will be at The Dural Country Club.

Elizabeth Farm & Lake Parramatta - \$20

Built in 1793, Elizabeth Farm is Australia's oldest surviving European dwelling with well-preserved artifacts and way of life from the 1800's. We'll have morning tea at Lake Parramatta and lunch at Club Parramatta.

Australian Botanical Gardens - \$10

Come see and take in the scents of Spring Blooms from Acacia, Banksia, Eucalyptus, Grevillea, Hibiscus and much more at the beautiful and picturesque gardens located in Mount Annan. We'll have lunch at Campbelltown RSL.

Cockatoo Island Tour - \$10 + Tour & Ferry

Want to see a different side to Sydney? Located in the heart of the Harbour, Cockatoo Island/ Wareamah is a source of adventure and inspiration due to its historic landmarks and popular attractions. Take a self-guided tour for \$6 per person and bring your Opal Card. Grab refreshments at one of the cafes on the island.

Middle Harbour Explorer - \$10

Sydney Harbour boasts many beautiful peninsulas and headlands, and Middle Head has some of the most stunning views. Also steeped in history are the many military relics dotted along the coast. Lunch will be at Balmoral Beach and their waterfront restaurants.

Government House Tour & Police Justice Museum - \$20

Come on a guided tour of the historic Government House, built in 1836. We'll also go to the Justice & Police Museum where you can walk the corridor of cells, check out the chilling collection of criminal weapons and hundreds of photos from the forensic archives. Lunch will be at the Sydney Fish Markets.
